

2021: Request for COVID-19 Medical Records

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

We are a group of physicians, pharmacists, lawyers, and other scientists who, in collaboration with affected people, the "Aerzte für Aufklärung" foundation, and the Dr. Fuellmich law firm, wish to investigate severe and potentially fatal courses of COVID-19.

Some of our scientists have been active in health management for many years. We have successfully specialized in evaluating patient-specific medical records, blood counts, and biochemical data and in deriving key information and the best possible recommendations for each individual's personal health.

The **basis** for this is always the most comprehensive possible view of a person, including his/her blood counts, medication profile, eating and drinking behavior, free time activities, and professional environment.

The **aim** is always the reduction of medications (if applicable, and then only based on a professional medical decision) and of the risk of secondary complications, such as heart attack, stroke, and severe thrombosis.

Our team of experts covers the areas of pharmacy, medicine, sports science, dietetics, and IT. Our activity does not include medical treatments. Medical therapy sovereignty is not touched by us.

As since March 2020 there have been numerous COVID-19-related specialist publications defining people with obesity, high blood pressure and/or type 2 diabetes as people at risk, the topic affects the professional activity of our physicians and pharmacists. - Pandemic risk of SARS-CoV-2 and mutating SARS-CoV

COVID-19 has been splitting society to an unprecedented extent. Our aim is to make people in our society be more tolerant and peaceful in dealing with each other again. This is only possible through understanding this disease. Those who recovered from serious illness and surviving dependents of COVID-19 victims can help stop this division of society, decrease severe courses and deaths, and make this disease easier to treat in the future.

Please provide us with medical records, i.e. yours or those of your deceased relatives, including blood counts and information on medication! Ideally, records (blood counts and, if available, medication plans) should cover the time from at least two years prior to the illness. Your data will be processed and analyzed under strict protection of your privacy (see "Purpose of the collection of COVID-19 patient data").

Purpose of the collection of COVID-19 patient data:

The purpose of our research is a complete an analysis as possible of the patient's physical condition before, during and hopefully after the illness. This includes medications, blood parameters and, in this case, PCR test results as well. This data can be used to evaluate the patient's state of health with regard to a possible causal connection with the patient's COVID-19 illness. For example, some drugs play a role in regulating the cell surface enzyme ACE2 (especially on lung cells, where SARS-CoV-2 docks via the spike protein). Some blood parameters (e.g. white blood cells, vitamin D, blood sugar, blood lipids) play a role in the assessment of immune strength. And since, for example, thromboses are supposed to represent a corona risk, a person's eating, drinking, and exercise behavior play a role as well. **To ensure maximum protection of patients' privacy, the use of personal data in our analysis will be kept as limited as possible. Any transmission of your data to other scientists mentioned in this form for further evaluation will be anonymized to eliminate any conclusions about the patient's identity.**
